Western Kansas is the world hub for the cattle feeding industry, and each year our Beef Industry Special explores important aspects of this nationwide industry. In past years we have interviewed top people in this industry such as: J. R. Simplot, the only American billionaire whose initial fortune was made entirely in agriculture; Dr. Glen Lofgreen, who developed the California Net Energy System; Dr. Don Good, former head of the Kansas State University Department of Animal Sciences; Loren Doll and Norbert Irsik, owners of the Irsik and Doll Company which built the early Ingalls Feedyard, and the late Dr. William Hale, often called “The Father of Processed Grain,” because of the steam processing and flaking techniques he developed. Today, up to 70% of the cattle fed in the U.S. are fed grains processed with technology developed by Dr. Hale at the University of Arizona.
